Covid

A reminder that any information e.g if your child or someone in your household is selfisolating, waiting for a test or when they have received a result should be sent by email to the school office at <u>greenfylde@educ.somerset.gov.uk</u> <u>even during the half term holiday</u>.

Children must not attend school if they have any Covid symptoms: a temperature (hot to touch on the chest or back), a new continuous cough or a loss of taste and smell.

Please can we also ask that the adult dropping off/picking up children still in school wears a mask if possible.
