A guide to when and how we are using online communication

Tapestry (Reception children)

We will continue to use Tapestry as part of our daily practice to record observations of the children whilst at school. We encourage you to add observations or wow moments of your child whilst at home. We will also be using Tapestry to share our weekly sharing letters. Our blended learning will also be added to Tapestry.

Class Dojo (Years 1-4)

We are still using Dojo for reward points and we will put reminders such as PE, reading books and Forest School on there. Please check this for occasional class updates. Class Dojo can also be used to message your child's class teacher however staff will only respond to messages in term-time between 8am and 6pm, Monday to Friday.

If your query is urgent, please contact the school office. As we are minimising items coming into school as part of our Covid restrictions, you can also upload photos to your child's portfolio (not as a message) so that your child can share this in-class. For example, your child may want to show something e.g. a new toy or pet. Can we please remind you to cut up all grapes, lengthways, cherry tomatoes and cocktail sausages? These foods are the perfect shape and size to lodge in a child's throat and can cause choking in small children as they are small enough to block airways.

We have also been focusing on Reading this week. The children have loved listening and joining in with many stories including "The Gingerbread Man" "Three Little Pigs". Also we have looking at rhyming activities, listening to letter sounds and nursery rhymes. We hope you enjoy looking at our Letters and Sounds booklet which we have sent by email as it gives some lovely activities, songs and rhymes for you to enjoy at home.

Adult Led Focus

Next week's focus is Writing. Please look for your Key person focus on Tapestry For two to three years the children may tell you about the different marks they make in writing and drawing. They may hold a chunky crayon, pencil, pen or paint brush and makes lines that go across, up and down or round and round.

For children who will be going to school they may - Sometimes tell you about drawings and paintings and what my writing means. When they see your writing, they may tell you what I think it means, like the shopping list says "beans and chips and ice cream". They may make the lines and marks that they need with a pencil.

Sound of the week

We are delighted to see all the pictures of the 'A Sound" on Tapestry this week, the children have found interesting ones like "Ant" and "Ambulance" and even an "Alligator ". Next week's sound will be the Letters Sound "T" how many things can you find beginning with a T

Sunflowers
