## **Covid 19 testing**

I know families should have received this by email yesterday but just wanted to add to the newsletter again to ensure all families receive.

We have become aware of families using LFT Lateral Flow Tests if their child has suspected Covid symptoms - <u>LFTs must not be used if a child has symptoms</u> as firstly, they are not designed for younger children and secondly, only a PCR test can be used to ascertain if someone with symptoms has Covid. This is in line with the Government Guidance, which was updated on the 10th May 2021.

From the latest guidance (10<sup>th</sup> May 2021):

Parents and carers will need to book a test if they or their child has symptoms - the main symptoms are:

a high temperature

a new continuous cough

a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

They must self-isolate immediately and not come to school (including siblings) if: they develop symptoms

they have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19 anyone in their household or support or childcare bubble develops symptoms of COVID-19 they are required to quarantine having recently visited countries outside the common travel area they have been advised to isolate by NHS test and trace or the PHE local health protection team

Anyone who displays symptoms of COVID-19 can and should get a test. Tests for symptomatic illness (PCR tests) can be booked online through the NHS testing and tracing for coronavirus (COVID-19) website <u>https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing/</u>, or ordered by telephone via NHS 119 for those without access to the internet. We also can provide a postal PCR test if families cannot access any of the other options.

Any information e.g if your child or someone in your household is self isolating, waiting for a test or when they have received a result should be sent by email to the school office at <u>greenfylde@educ.somerset.gov.uk</u>.

We are all hoping we are on the way out of Covid restrictions but we still currently need to follow all the Government Guidance so we are working together to keep our school community safe.



## **School Comms**

Please look out for emails to help families use our new School Comms system which will allow families to choose school meals and book clubs and after/before school care electronically. We feel this will help make our systems more efficient but do contact us if you experience difficulties in using the system once it launches.

## Safeguarding

## **Parents' Evening Questionnaire Results**

Thank you to everyone who completed our Parents' Evening Questionnaire and we had 25 responses from families (10% of families in school).

Results showed:

100% of families found booking a time easy to do 100% found 10 minutes a sufficient amount of time 64% would like the option of telephone meetings to continue once we return to face to face 88% found the meeting informative and worthwhile for understanding children's progress (rest, 3 families were unsure)

From your comments:

You said: Telephone calls allowed more parents to participate as were convenient and generally on time.

We did: We will keep telephone conversations as an option for meetings in the next academic year

**You said**: It was appreciated when teachers arranged for longer conversations if required **We did**: We always welcome communication with parents and meetings can be arranged by contacting the school office.

**You said**: We would have liked to see the children's work as well as their classrooms. **We did:** We agree but with Covid this has not been a part of our risk assessment. Hopefully, once guidance to schools changes, we will be able to have families coming in again to see children's books and classrooms and we will return to our 'My Learning Weeks' where children will bring home a snapshot of a week's learning every term. Books will as usual be sent home at the end of the academic year.

**You said:** Please could slots just be in an evening for parents to attend who work **We did**: Looking at our school community we are aware that there are families who work day hours but also a number who work nights or varying shifts. This year appointments were given until 6pm and we appreciate this didn't work for all but for some working parents they found they could fit the appointment in to breaks or lunchtimes. We will aim to go back to one evening of appointments to 7pm next academic year as we appreciate some families prefer these but also want to balance this against the wellbeing of staff.

You said: Please could we have Zoom calls instead

**We did:** We did consider Zoom calls but in the first Parents' Evening we had no internet available on site and by the second we realised that with the rest of school working we couldn't guarantee a stable bandwidth. Hopefully, we are getting improved broadband through the Government's rural schools scheme so this may be an option in the future.


