Our school community

Our new Reception are settling in and are already actively involved in school life. It was a pleasure to hear one of the Reception teachers telling me how kind she had noticed the older children were to the new starters at lunchtime and this is a credit to the children.

Thank you for keeping with us as we all get used to the new system for drop off and collection. Just to remind families, now Reception children are more familiar with the school we are happy for them to come in any gate however the front gate and double gates (Wharf Lane) will let them enter the school nearer to where their teachers are waiting on the playground. We know some families would prefer the staggered starts and separate gates for classes but equally we know some prefer the current system, realistically with over 250 families we are unlikely to ever find a system that suits everyone and we are seeing this new system become more efficient as everyone gets used to the changes. We will monitor both the morning and afternoon sessions to look for any potential changes. One area we would like to remind families about is please can families only bring one adult at drop off/pick up to minimise the numbers around and in school.

A parent has also raised a concern about children on scooters outside of school, specifically on Wharf Lane. Please can we ask families to check that children stay on the pavement rather than the road. A reminder as well that we do have storage for scooters if you wish to leave them at school during the day. As one scooter can look like another we suggest adding a special sticker or mark that your child will recognise. Scooter parking is located by the double and back gates on Wharf Lane.

In regard to Wharf Lane, to be fair to pedestrians and our neighbours, please can we request vehicles do not go down this road past school unless going to a specific property and please do not park on the single yellow lines (unless with a disabled parking permit) or on the school hatchings. This helps reduce the number of cars at pick up/drop off and makes it safer for the children.

Finally, a thank you to all our families when we had our fire alarm go off at 3.30pm yesterday. Not a time we would ever choose and thank you for helping us get everyone away from the buildings whilst we established what had happened.



Swimming

As we are swimming again please can we ask that if possible your child wears a one piece swimming costume/swim shorts rather than board shorts or two pieces. This is to try and make swimming as safe as possible for children learning so that they have full movement and minimise water drag etc.

Uniform

The children are all looking very smart at the start of term but we are noticing that a lot of uniform is not named and one jumper/cardigan looks very much like another. Please can you check all clothing is named and that does include underwear when swimming.

Water

All children must have a refillable water bottle in school and this should contain still water (not juice) as it is there to hydrate the children through the day rather than as a food. Children are still welcome to have juice with their lunchboxes. These must be named and ideally ones that the children as they get older can refill themselves.

Morrisons

If you shop at Morrisons please would you consider nominating Greenfylde as your recipient of the current Good to Grow tokens. School will be able to redeem these for a wide range of gardening equipment that will help with our Gardening classroom and Forest School area.

Headlice

A reminder that headlice are not scared away by Covid so please keep checking your children's hair at least weekly so any lice or eggs can be treated quickly.

We know you all have fabulous imaginations and we have seen some amazing designs over the years. We hope lots of you will take part and please speak to any of the teachers for further details.


