Covid

A reminder that any information e.g if your child is waiting for a test or when they have received a result should be sent by email to the school office at greenfylde@educ.somerset.gov.uk. Your child must not come in if they have any Covid symptoms (high temperature, loss of taste/smell, new continuous cough). If your child has symptoms or is identified as a close contact, you should get a PCR test https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test and not use lateral flow tests (LFTs) as these are not suitable for our age of children.




