Please can all sickness absence be reported through the school office (email to <u>Greenfylde@educ.somerset.gov.uk</u> or message on the answer machine 01460 52686) and not via Dojo/Tapestry, as this is not checked through the day and it is important any absence is correctly reported on the register.



Community

To maintain good relations with our neighbours in the community please can we ask families not to wait in the gate area of the properties opposite the school on Wharf Lane, Summervale Mews, in order to give them clear entry and exit to their properties.

Covid

What to do if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) or tests positive for COVID-19

Symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are a new, continuous cough, or a high temperature, or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), they should get a PCR test and remain at home at least until the result is known <u>and they are fever free (without</u> <u>medication) for at least 24 hours.</u>

If **negative**, the child can end self-isolation and return to school once well; If **positive**, the child should isolate until at least 10 days after their symptoms appeared.

If the child has a positive test result, but does not have <u>symptoms</u>, they should stay at home and self-isolate for 10 days from the date the positive test was taken. This isolation period will be extended if they go on to develop symptoms by counting 10 full days from the day following their symptom onset. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for a PCR test (the normally available test type) and this can be arranged via <u>https://www.gov.uk/get-</u> <u>coronavirus-test</u> or by calling 119.


A reminder that any information e.g if your child is waiting for a test or when they have received a result should be sent by email to the school office at <u>greenfylde@educ.somerset.gov.uk</u>, please don't send via School Comms as the office email is checked out of hours unlike the School Comms app. Your child must not come in or be brought to school if they have any Covid symptoms.

If your child is identified as a close contact, they should get a PCR test <u>https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test.</u> In these current amber measures, if your child is a close contact it is recommended that they lateral flow test daily until a negative PCR test result is received.

When reporting absence please state the symptoms your child is experiencing as depending on these it changes their coding on the register. If we receive messages with just descriptions such as 'unwell' then the office will need to follow this up with you in a telephone call. Please can we ask families to be respectful to any calls from the office re potential Covid illness as they are only following the Government guidance.

We have had a busy week at Sunny IIe this week. The children have enjoyed playing games especially 'Bingo' and 'Pairs' the memory games. Some of our children have visited the park to explore 'Sophie Louise' Pirate Ship.

The children have helped make play dough and coloured rice, to play with along with making Polar Bear models.

Play Dough

The children absolutely love to play with 'Play Dough' from making birthday cakes with candles to cutting it with scissors, to making houses for their animals. Play dough is extremely versatile, and can help with all areas of your child's development. Below is the recipe that we use in Sunny IIe, any colour can be added, glitter or smell to the uncooked play dough mixture.

cup plain flour
tbsp Oil
Cup water
Cup Salt
tbsp Cream of Tartar
Food Colouring / Fragrances

Add all dry ingredients together and mix well. Add water, oil and food colouring / fragrances to a jug, Make a well in the centre of the dry ingredients and gradually add the water mixture mixing together well.

Cook in the microwave for 2 minutes, remove and stir, repeat cooking until mixture is dry. Allow to cool slightly, take out of bowl and kneed. Ensure mixture is cold before allowing children to play with it.

Our children love to mix in glitter or sequins to the playdough after it has been cooked.
