Covid

What to do if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) or tests positive for COVID-19

Symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are a new, continuous cough, or a high temperature, or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), they should get a PCR test and remain at home at least until the result is known <u>and they are fever free (without</u> <u>medication) for at least 24 hours.</u>

If **negative**, the child can end self-isolation and return to school once well; If **positive**, the child should isolate until at least 10 days after their symptoms appeared.

If the child has a positive test result, but does not have <u>symptoms</u>, they should stay at home and self-isolate for 10 days from the date the positive test was taken. This isolation period will be extended if they go on to develop symptoms by counting 10 full days from the day following their symptom onset. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for a PCR test (the normally available test type) and this can be arranged via <u>https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</u> or by calling 119.

A reminder that any information e.g if your child is waiting for a test or when they have received a result should be sent by email to the school office at <u>greenfylde@educ.somerset.gov.uk</u>, please don't send via School Comms as the office email is checked out of hours unlike the School Comms app. Your child must not come in or be brought to school if they have any Covid symptoms.

If your child is identified as a close contact, they should get a PCR test <u>https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test.</u> In these current amber measures, if your child is a close contact it is recommended that they lateral flow test daily until a negative PCR test result is received.

When reporting absence please state the symptoms your child is experiencing as depending on these it changes their coding on the register. If we receive messages with just descriptions such as 'unwell' then the office will need to follow this up with you in a telephone call. Please can we ask families to be respectful to any calls from the office re potential Covid illness as they are only following the Government guidance.

<u>COVID</u>

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If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), they should get a PCR test and remain at home at least until the result is known and they are fever free (without medication) for at least 24 hours.

If negative, the child can end self-isolation and return to school once well; If positive, the child should isolate until at least 10 days after their symptoms appeared. If the child has a positive test result, but does not have symptoms, they should stay at home and self-isolate for 10 days from the date the positive test was taken. This isolation period will be extended if they go on to develop symptoms by counting 10 full days from the day following their symptom onset.

Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for a PCR test (the normally available test type) and this can be arranged via <u>https://www.gov.uk/getcoronavirus-test or by calling 119</u>.

Your child must not come in or be brought to pre-school if they have any Covid symptoms. If your child is identified as a close contact, they should get a PCR test

https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test. In these current amber measures, if your child is a close contact it is recommended that they lateral flow test daily until a negative PCR test result is received.

Flu vaccination clinics are open for 2 and 3 year olds!

In Somerset our rates of flu vaccination for 2 and 3 year olds are slightly low this year compared to last year and we are also lower than other areas in the South West, so we have a bit of catching up to do. Flu is still circulating and remains a threat for us all, especially if it is combined with other respiratory illnesses or other complications like pneumonia. This year as we start to mix more, we are seeing a stronger than usual winter emergence of other respiratory viruses which can combine to increase the seriousness of flu infection. A flu vaccination will protect children but for this age group we know that onward spread of flu is much more likely than for adults so ensuring children are vaccinated will protect all those they are in contact with including family and nursery staff.

All children aged 2 or 3 by 31st August 2021, (those born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2019) can receive a flu vaccination at GP clinics. Children who are 2 or 3 will have a nasal spray, so no injections!
