A quick guide for Covid If any of your household has any of these symptoms they must go for a Covid test: • High temperature: any new high temperature where the person feels hot to touch on their chest or back. • New continuous cough: coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours. • Loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste If anyone in your household has these symptoms and/or is waiting for a test result everyone in the household must self isolate as per guidance. • This means children of school and pre-school age do not attend school or pre-school until the person with symptoms has a negative test result or 14 days self isolation has been completed. • If in doubt at any time, please contact the school office who are happy to talk you through the guidance.
