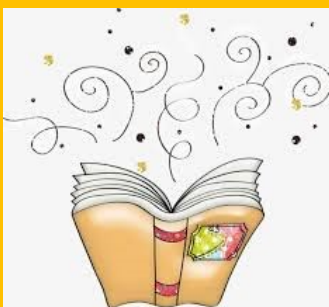


Starting school with Greenfylde Dog

Greenfylde Dog wondered how he would see school as he knew people were being very careful with visiting places due to something called Covid 19 that could make people ill.



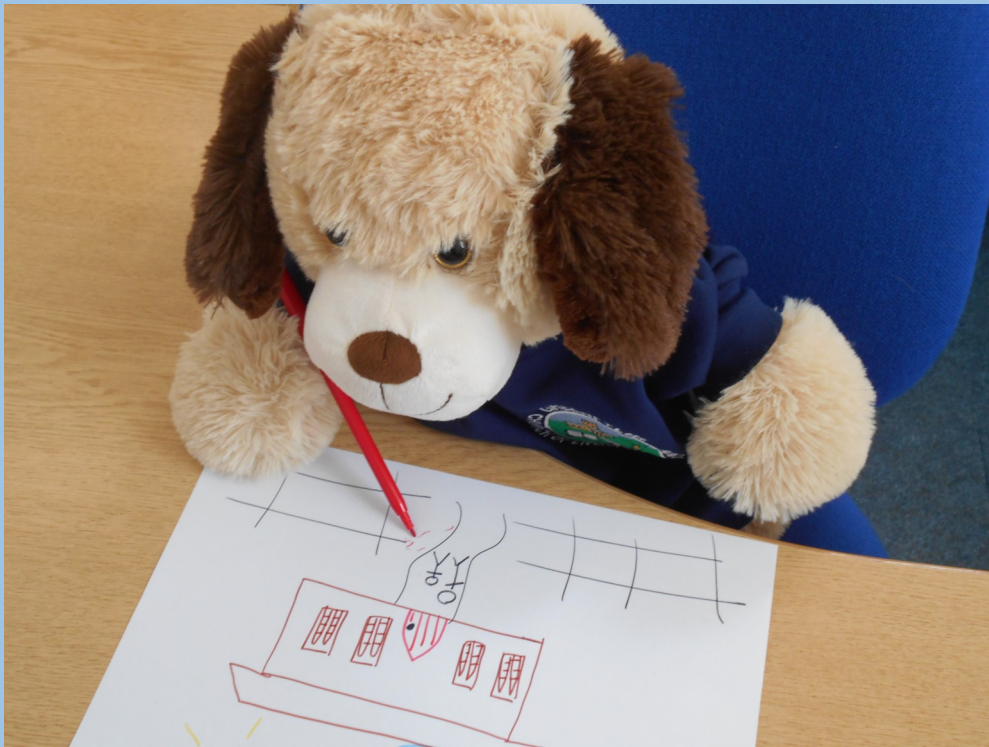
