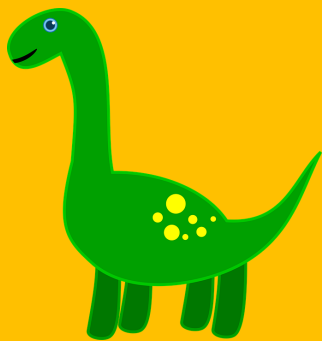


What can I play? asks Greenfylde Dog
